

2020 ST. JOHN THE EVANGELIST CYO INTRAMURAL BASKETBALL PROGRAM GRADES JRK – 3

Kindergarten/JrK Program (Grade JrK/K)

WHO: Includes all children currently in Kindergarten/Jr Kindergarten from St. John the Evangelist School,

St. John's CCD, and the greater community. You do not need to be a SJE parishioner for

your child to play.

WHAT: Children meet each Saturday, usually in the morning, in the St. John's gym for a one-hour clinic.

The program focuses on teaching children basic basketball skills in a fun, low-impact environment.

Each child will receive their own basketball to keep.

WHEN: Tentatively held on Saturday mornings from early/mid January through mid/late February

Intramural Basketball (Grades 1-3)

WHO: Includes all children currently in Grades 1-3 from St. John's School, St. John's CCD and the greater

community. For Intramurals, players do not need to be a member of the school or parish.

WHAT: Teams meet once or twice a week for one-hour practices in the St. John's gym. Intramural games

are played on Sunday afternoons in the school gym. Traditionally, the 1st grade league is co-ed and there is a boys and girls specific league for the 2nd & 3rd graders. Final breakdown of leagues

is based on numbers of participants for each grade.

WHEN: Plan is for practices to begin early January. Games begin early/mid-January and will run into early

March (with HoopsFest skills contest held the weekend after the last week of games).
