- II. Approval of Prior Meeting Minutes (September 14, 2021)
- III. Home and School Association (HSA) Updates
  - a. Novemberfest was successful very successful. Final accounting to be reviewed.
  - b. HSA is currently working on BWS Reimagined. It will be called Santa's Nativity. Chris Desrocher is able to help edit photos. Rebecca Desrocher will staff Santa's workshop. Craft kits are being solicited for donation.
  - c. The popcorn sale resulted in a profit to the school of \$12K.
- IV. Administrative Items
  - a. Current enrollment No change since the last SAB meeting (188 students).
  - b. Ms. Keeton gave a presentation on the latest ADW guidelines for tuition rates for the 2022/2023 school year.
  - c. COVID-19 No specific COVID taskforce will be formed, as ADW is giving direction and it would be best to avoid having conflicting policies. A survey was sent out to see who would be interested in participating in weekly COVID-19 testing. There was an 80% positive response. Training was provided for the school nurse, Mrs. Colburn and Ms. Keeton, with the goal of starting up testing on the Wednesday after Thanksgiving. Ms. Keeton to remind families to be cautious about COVID-19 protocols when celebrating the holiday.
  - d. Staffing updates None to report.

  - a. The roof replacement project will cost approximately \$400K. We are hoping to use aging schools grant funds and monies from the endowment at the end of last year that were not used.
  - b. A committee has been formed for long-term strategic capital planning.
