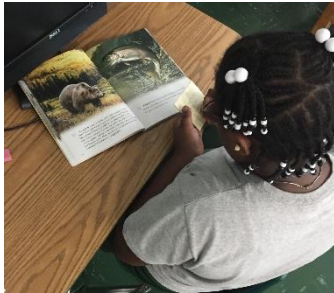

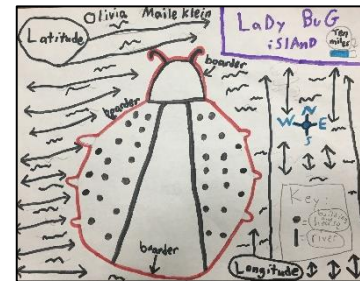
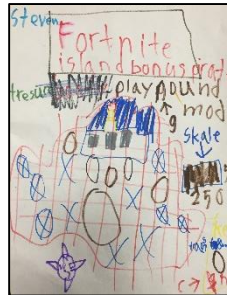


## Maps, Maps, and More Maps!

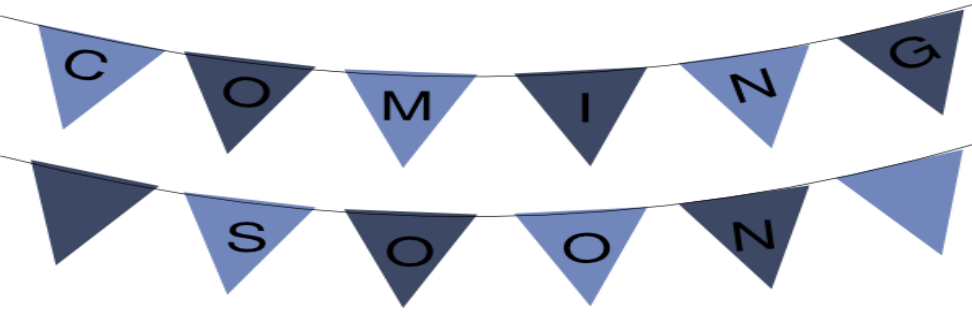

## The Grammar Police

In Grammar, students have moved from learning about nouns to pronouns. Students had a special challenge of Thursday when they became Ghostbusters! They needed to find the ghosts around the classroom, identify the pronouns in the sentences written on the ghosts, and then tell if the pronoun was singular or plural. For some ghosts, students had to change the noun in the sentence into a pronoun.





- **Math:** Adding and subtracting 3 digit number with and without regrouping.
- **Reading:** Developing opinions about reading; narrative nonfiction.
- **Religion:** Vocations (Single Life, Married Life, Religious Life, Priesthood).
- **Science:** Space – Patterns in how the Sun and Moon move/appear to move.
